Great Curry Run 2012 “Run it – Walk it – Ride it – Stagger it”

Saturday 21st April 2012, 9am



Thanks to the efforts of the whole school community last March, we managed to raise nearly £20,000 for the Soldiers' Charity to help support the injured and bereaved and orphaned from recent conflicts. You may recall one element of the fund raising was a run / walk of 19.28km on Big Curry Day: this distance being 10 metres for each of the 1928 servicemen killed or wounded in Afghanistan up to the end of December 2010.

The distance for 2012 will depend on the number of casualties at year end: as of 15th November we would be doing 22.09 km (befitting 2209 casualties). We fear a final distance of 22.5 km

Many of the staff who took part last year plan to do so again.
