It is taught as a series of units, which are sequenced to cover the full GCSE specification and build students' knowledge and levels of complexity of language over time. **Prep:** 2 prep tasks per week. Tasks may include grammar consolidation tasks, vocabulary learning, exam-style comprehension tasks and end of unit assessment preparation. 3 equally-weighted written examination papers (Listening, Reading & Writing), plus 1 speaking examination which is undertaken with their classroom teacher. Listening: Multiple choice and short answer tasks based on a series of recordings on a range of topics from the course. Reading: Translation into English, plus a series of multiple-choice and short answer tasks from reading a selection of texts on a range of topics from the course. Writing: Translation into Spanish, plus 2-3 written tasks of 40-50/80-90/130-150 words on a range of topics from the curriculum. BREADTH We are currently planning a year 10 school trip to Barcelona in February 2025. Other extra-curricular activities include: A theatre trip to London to see a play performed entirely in Spanish - La Casa de Bernarda Alba by Federico García Lorca Opportunity to watch a play performed in Spanish at St George's aimed at KS4 students Opportunity to engage with creative translation materials and enter the Anthea Bell Translation Prize organised by The Queen's College, Oxford
